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Description

It provides the possibility for multiple users to collaborate. Jam is a special Google file with minimal interface and tools, so it is very easy to use; you can easily edit or move the elements on the pages (frames) using a smartphone, a graphics tablet or the touch screen of your phone.

The finished work can be downloaded and saved in PDF or image format.

You can automatically associate a Jamboard with Google Meet meetings, giving meeting participants read only or editing rights.

Advantages

- simple user interface
- contribution

Disadvantages

- there are only six colours to choose from
- there are only four pen types
- on some devices, hand-drawn designs will not be visible

- text formatting options are minimal
- the note text cannot be formatted
- **The teacher and the student have the same editing rights.**

Usage in teaching/learning

We can create visual learning aids that can be shared for group collaboration.

Whether in the classroom with a projector or during online activities, we can use them to work together.
